CHBE Policy on Masters Degree Comprehensive Examinations

The following table indicates whether or not a comprehensive examination is required for each of the Masters degrees awarded by the CHBE Department. When a comprehensive examination is required, the type of examination is also indicated.

- For the MS CHE (Non-Thesis), the student's professional paper is reviewed by major advisor only (not full committee)

While the Department policy is that a comprehensive examination is not required for the MS CHE (Non-Thesis), the student's major advisor may require the student to publically present and defend the professional paper.
